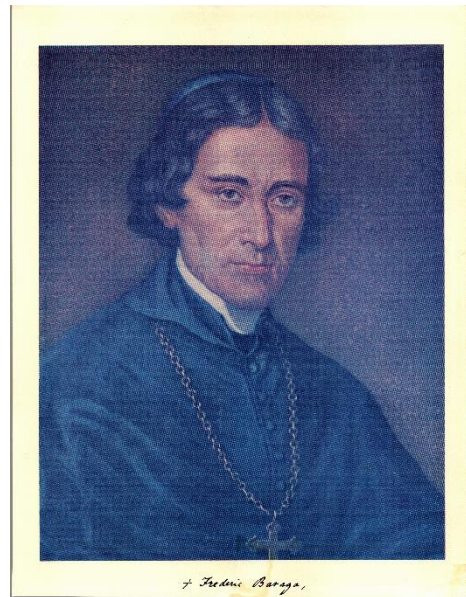
Scrip
