until 4:15, before the 4:30pm Mass.

**Sundays** after the 9am Mass at Sacred Heart until 10:30am and at St. Clement after the 11am Mass. After the 9:30am Mass at St. Mary/St. Charles until 11am.

All times are dependent on the availability of a priest and may be adjusted to allow time for the priest to get from Sacred Heart to St. Clement on Sundays in bad weather.

If you cannot make it to one of the above times, you are encouraged to seek a neighboring parish that may have other times available.

All confessions take place in the confessionals according to distancing guidelines. Because of limited space, penitents are asked to stand as there is no room for a kneeler. At St. Mary/St. Charles and St. Clement, confessions are face-to-face. There is a screen at Sacred Heart. The parish office is used at St. Clement because the confessional does not allow for social distancing.
